Getting Started with QuickCheck

Who this guide is for

Unity QuickCheck is a free browser side panel tool for content editors, testers, developers, and designers to help catch accessibility and content quality issues on any live web page. It also lets you select your role, so you see only the checks that matter to you.

What you'll need before you start

- Google Chrome (Google recommends using Chrome for extensions)

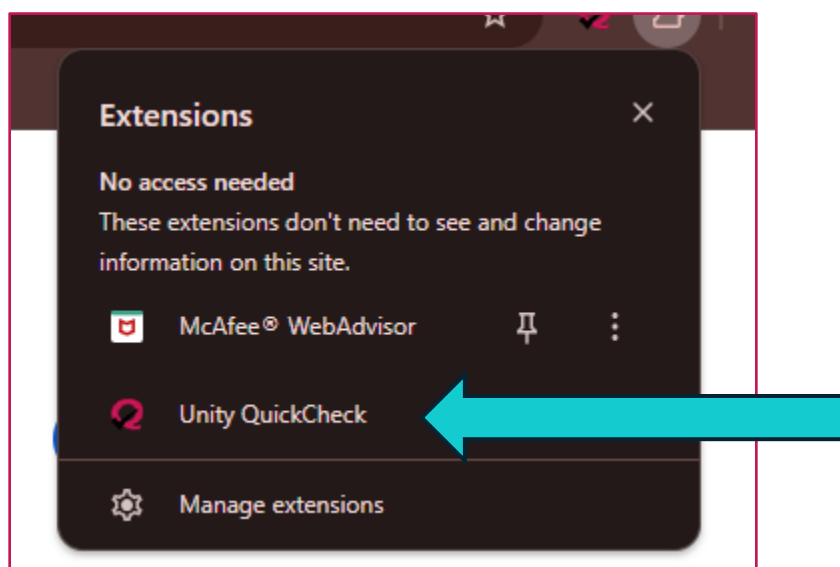
Step 1: Download Unity QuickCheck

Open the [Unity QuickCheck](#) listing from the Chrome Store.

Click “Add to Chrome” and complete the Chrome prompts to finish installing the extension

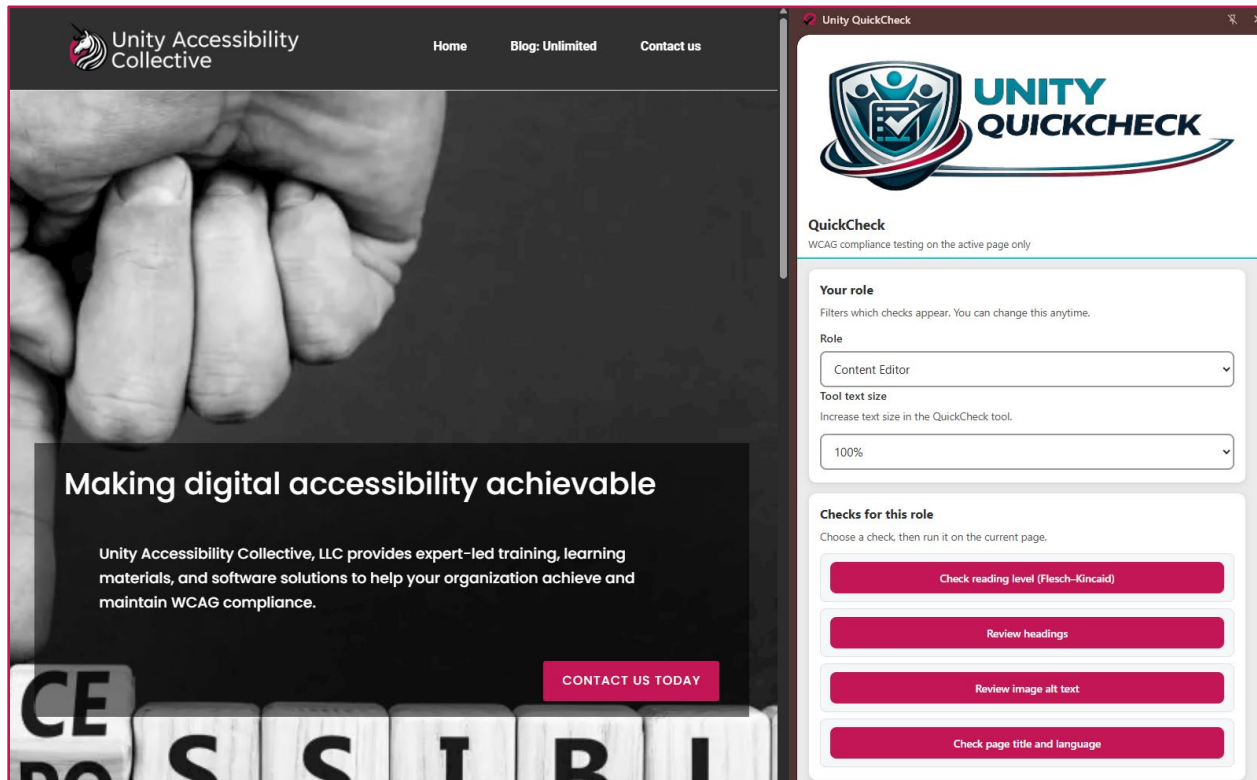
Step 2: Pin QuickCheck to your Chrome toolbar

In your Chrome browser, open the Extensions (located in the browser toolbar) and find the Unity QuickCheck Extension.



Step 3: Start testing with Unity QuickCheck

Pull up any live webpage you want to check, make sure it's the active tab, and open Unity QuickCheck to start catching accessibility and content-quality issues right away.
